

## **PRIZES & AWARDS 2025**

### **Newcomers' Prize**

Certificate for the most points across all sections, by a newcomer to the parish of Wellow. The exhibitor must have moved in after 1st September 2024.

### **The RHS Banksian Medal**

Awarded for the most points in the horticultural classes - Vegetables, Fruits and Flowers Sections. (Competitors who have won The Banksian Medal in the last two years are not eligible to win. Previous winners are Judith Wetherall in 2023 and Duncan Hammerton in 2024).

### **The Farmer's Cup**

Best entry in class 1 - Collection of 5 varieties of vegetables.

### **The Patrick Hartley Memorial Salver**

Best entry in class 10 - Collection of 5 salad vegetables

### **The Wellow & District Challenge Cup**

Most points in Section A Vegetables **(Hort Soc Members only)**.

### **The Ted Welch Memorial Cup**

Most points in Section B Fruit

### **The Ken Manning's Shield**

Most points in Section C Novelty Garden

### **The Late Joane Rittner Cup**

Best entry in Class 70. A collection of wild flowers in a vase.

### **A certificate will be awarded for best in Section D Flowers**

### **The Sarah Moore Trophy**

Best display in section E Floral Art

### **The Colin Tremellen Cup**

Most points in Section G Art and Photography

### **The Combe Hay Cup**

Most points in Sections H & I Cookery and Preserves

### **For those aged under 17 years old**

### **The Emma Rose Cup**

Awarded for the most points across all the classes.

### **The Junior Gardener's Cup**

Most points in Section K Vegetables

### **The Sue Rodford Cup**

The child in pre-school with the most points in classes 130-132.

### **The St. Julian's Cup**

Awarded to a St. Julian's School pupil for the most points.
