RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS

- No entries whatsoever will be accepted after the date/time shown.
- Photographs (classes 89 & 90) must be emailed to flowershow@hortsoc.wellow.org to arrive no later than Thursday 22nd August 2025.
- Other classes must be registered at the Village Hall, Wellow on FRIDAY 29th August 2025, 2pm until 7pm, to collect entry tickets, OR the entry formed must be emailed to flowershow@hortsoc. wellow.org to arrive no later than Thursday 28th August 2025, and collect tickets from the Flower Show Secretaries on the morning of the Show.
- An exhibitor may make any number of entries in a class but is eligible for only one prize.
- The Committee reserves the right to visit the garden of any exhibitor, who must show all produce in a growing state.
- Exhibits must be placed in the 'Flower and Produce Marquee' between 7.45am and 9.45am on the day of the Show. Entry tickets must be firmly attached to the exhibit.
- No person, other than the stewards and judges may enter the marquee after 10:00am and before the Show opens.
- The judge's decisions are final. A judge may withhold an award if in their opinion an exhibit is of insufficient merit to make an award.
- No exhibit shall be removed from the 'Flower and Produce Marquee' until after 3.00pm. Any produce left after 4.45pm will be disposed of.
- Cups and other awards will be presented on the day. Prize monies will be paid out at the Treasurer's tent between 3.00pm and 4.45pm Monies not claimed by 4.45pm will be deemed to have been donated to the Society's funds.
- Cups remain the property of the Society and holders are held responsible for any loss or damage incurred while in their possession. Cups must be returned by 31st July 2026.
- The Committee will take all reasonable care of exhibits but will not be liable for any loss or damage.
- All communications regarding entries or other matters should be sent to the Flower Show Secretaries.
- Points are scored in each class: First 3 points, second 2 points and third 1 point. In the event of a tie, the highest number of Firsts decides.
