

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS

- 1 No entries will be accepted after the specified date/time.
- 2 Classes must be registered at the Village Hall, Wellow on **FRIDAY 10th July 2026, 4pm until 7pm**, to collect entry tickets. Alternatively, the entry form must be emailed to flowershow@hortsoc.wellow.org to arrive no later than **4pm FRIDAY 10th July 2026**, and entry tickets collected from the Flower Show Secretaries on the morning of the Show.
- 3 With the exception of the Photographic Section, an exhibitor may make any number of entries in a class but is eligible for only one prize. Only one entry per exhibitor is allowed in the Photographic section.
- 4 The Committee reserves the right to visit the garden of any exhibitor, who must show all produce in a growing state.
- 5 Exhibits must be placed in the '**Flower and Produce Marquee**' between **7.45am and 9.45am** on the day of the Show. **Entry tickets must be firmly attached to the exhibit.** For classes in the Horticultural Sections, please write the variety name (if known) on the reverse of the entry ticket.
- 6 Entries cannot be made with items that have been shown before and must have been grown/made within the last 12 months.
- 7 No person, other than the stewards and judges may enter the marquee after 10:00am and before the Show opens.
- 8 The judge's decisions are final. A judge may withhold an award if in their opinion an exhibit is of insufficient merit to make an award.
- 9 No exhibit shall be removed from the Flower and Produce Marquee until after 3.00pm. Any produce left after 4.45pm will be disposed of.
- 10 Trophies and other awards will be presented on the day. Prize monies not claimed by 4.45pm will be deemed to have been donated to the Society's funds.
- 11 Trophies remain the property of the Society and holders are responsible for any loss or damage incurred while in their possession.
- 12 Cups must be returned by 30th April 2027.
- 13 The Committee will take all reasonable care of exhibits but will not be liable for any loss or damage.
- 14 All communications regarding entries or other matters should be sent to the Flower Show Secretaries.
- 15 Points are scored in each class: First 3 points, second 2 points and third 1 point. In the event of a tie, the highest number of Firsts decides.
